Personally came before me, a Clerk of the Superior Court in and for
aforesaid County and State, Jesse Baiscoe
citizen of the County of Baltimore, State of Maryland, reputable
and entitled to credit, and who, being duly sworn, declare in relation to aforesaid claim, as follows:

was wounded
in right Index finger carrying away part of
the finger. wound at right of Fort Harrison
at Camp Baton Rouge on or about 29th day September
1864 - treated at Field Hospital. about one month
then reported to Regiment - was wounded
in the head at Johns Island South Carolina
9th day of July 1864 - Lay unconscious about 18 minutes
was treated at General Hospital at Beaufort
South Carolina where I was treated
one month. the finger wound was
received while in a Picket Skirmish

The wound in the head was received
at Johns Island immediately after we relieved
a white Regiment. was fired upon by
the Enemy -

I have not been in the military
or naval service since the date of my discharge
from the 7th Regiment U. S. Troops -

I don't know the residence of
any of my officers. so I make the affidavits
of two comrades in line with
