PAROL EVIDENCE AS TO ORIGIN OF DISABILITY.

Testimony of ~~commissioned officer~~ Comrade John Young & Tho^s Proctor, Co^s G. & I. 7th A. S. C. I.

(filed, January 9th, 1872), that they well knew that, & have perfect & personal knowledge that he rec^d. a G. I. W. carrying away part of the right index finger while in action on the night of Fort Harrison Va. Sept, 29/64. — Also that that, on or about the 9th of July/64, at Johns Island S. C. rec^d. a G. I. W. in the head. — that their means of knowing of the facts was from being personal friends to claimant.

Testimony of Comrade & Tho^s Proctor, & John Young, Co^s G. & I. 7th A. S. C. I.

(filed, Jan'y 30, 1872), that that, was wounded by the enemy's fire, by
