

DECLARATION OF A WIDOW FOR ACCRUED PENSION.

STATE OF MarylandCOUNTY OF St Marys ss:

On this 15 day of April, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and ten
 personally appeared before me, a justice of the peace within and for the county and
 State aforesaid, Emily B. Biscoe, aged 63 years,
 a resident of Peonons, County of St Marys,
 State of Maryland, who being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration
 in order to obtain the pension which had accrued to her husband, named below, at the time of his death.

That she is the widow of goriah Biscoe
 who served as private in 7 Regt U.S. Inf
[State rank and designation of organization or name of vessel.]
 and who was a pensioner of the United States by certificate No. 150050, on the roll of the Pension
 Agency at Washington Dc; that the last payment of his pension was made to
 the 4th day of December, 1904; that he died on the 7 day of February 1907

That she was married under the name of Emily B. Washington to said pensioner
 at St Nicholas Church on the 19 day of October, 181901
 by Rev Francis Gulleton; that there was no legal barrier to the marriage;
 that she had never been previously married; that the soldier had never been previously married.

we were never divorced and lived together up to his death
