We have the honor to appeal from the decision of the Commissioner of Pensions in rejecting the claim for original invalid pension, Act of June 27, 1890, filed in behalf of Josiah Briscoe, late of Co. I, 7th U. S. C. T., Cert. No. 120,050.

This claim was rejected upon the ground that the allowance of the same would confer no benefit. We invite attention to the testimony of Dr. Henry Richardson and to the testimony of Jeff Jarbo; also to the testimony of George Cacine and that of George W. Matthews. Our contention is that the claimant is entitled to a rating under the new law that would prove beneficial for him to accept.
