"Every thinking Lutheran must have grave concern about the outcome. It is easy to become pessimistic and discouraged and conclude that there is nothing to do about it. The responsibility upon the Lutherans of the world today is tremendous. The call of the hour is to stand up and face up to these high responsibilities and use them as opportunities. We must shake off complacency, formality, and indifference. It is a time for faith and heroic God-inspired action. This is our day of grace, our great opportunity."
