Baltimore January 14th 1864

The Board met, - read and approved yesterday's proceedings as recorded.

Mrs. John Somerville, Huntingtown, Calvert County, presented a claim for compensation for slave Ben, enlisted by Genl. Biney; he had no certificate, and was advised to obtain one from the Mustering Office.

Mrs. Cornelia Blake, Calvert County, claims payment for three slaves enlisted in the U. S. Service.

Mr. Geo. Middlekauf, Hagerstown, Md. appeared, to ask remuneration for slaves Daniel Sifus, alias Fox, and John Sifus, alias Fox, whom he had enlisted. He presented a receipt signed by "James Smith, Capt. & Pro. Marshal of 4th District of Maryland; - and requests the Board to send him blanks.

Mrs. M. A. C. Armstrong, Jr. 152 N. Bond St. Balt., claims payment for one slave Letticy Chandler or Letticy Armstrong, enlisted in Accomac Co. Va.; she has no certificate. Asks for blanks.

Miss S. E. Chandler asks remuneration for her slave George Chandler, who enlisted in Washington D.C.

Mr. Hanson Y. Bartholomew, Bird Hill, Carroll Co. Md. claims compensation for slave Henry Smith, enlisted
