Note. The following order was obtained from the Court yesterday and have been Recorded in the proceeding of Court of 14th Instant

via. Ordered by the Orphans Court of Queen Anne's County that Madison Brown Adm^r of Joseph W. Price dec^d sell so many of the negroes belonging to the estate of said deceased as are included in a mortgage bill of sale to the Hon^{ble} J. B. Eccleston as may be necessary to liquidate said mortgage debt principal & interest & that at his discretion he sell said negroes upon giving days notice at public or private sale (provided that he shall not sell at private sale for less than the appraised value) & ordered further that at his discretion he sell either for cash or on a credit of six months on obligation with security.
