Wards of Elizabeth Ann Turpin, be received, filed, and recorded.

Ordered that the 13th Guardian accounts of John H. & George W. Cook, wards of John Hewitt dec^d, & exhibited by James Merrick Executor of said dec^d, be received, filed, and recorded.

On application the Court appoint as the guardian to the said John H. & George W. Cook, Clinton Cook Esq., who executes a bond for each ward in the penal sum of two thousand dollars, with James Merrick, and Joseph K. Cook as his securities.

Ordered that the last will and Testament of Elizabeth Heathers late of Queen Arms County dec^d, be admitted to probat.
