Ordered, that the Inventory of personal property of Pere Brown dec^d, be received. On application of Sam^l Brown Adm^r of Pere Brown dec^d, Ordered that he sell on a credit of six months the whole personal property of said dec^d, negroes & plate excepted, the sum being money to pay debts.

Ordered that Sam^l Brown Adm^r of Pere Brown dec^d, give the notice required by law to the creditors of dec^d, to present their respective claims, & that publication be made in a Centre Ville newspaper.

Ordered that John B Thomas, John Brown, Enoch George, Charles Stevens and John W. Bryan, be & they are hereby appointed to be School Fund commissioners for Queen Anns County, to serve twelve months from this date.

Ordered that the account of sales of the personal property of Matilda Nickerson dec^d, be received, filed, and recorded.

Ordered that the 4th accounts of Henrich, George W & John W Tammam, wards of Francis Ann Travitt, formerly Francis Ann Tammam be received.

Ordered that Richard Mellington Adm^r of B Non with the will annexed of Samuel Chase dec^d, Ordered that he sell at public or private sale & on a credit or for cash at his discretion, the whole of the whole of the Eastern Shore Rail Road Stock he owing to dec^d estate.

On application of Tho^s B Bookers Executor of Elizabeth Heathers dec^d, Ordered, that for the purpose of paying the debts of the dec^d, he sell at private or public sale, for cash or on a credit at his discretion, Negs Amanda, provided if at private sale for not less than the appraised value.

Ordered that the indentures of apprenticeship of James & Williams who binds himself to Edward Hamilton be received filed and recorded.
