In application of Josiah Mafsey guardian to Indiana John J. & Harrison D. Mafsey Ordered that he sell at his discretion at public or private sale & for cash or on a credit Negro woman Hannah belonging to his said wards, Also Boy George belonging to same & on same terms except that he is not to be removed from the State of Maryland.

Ordered that the account of sales of Eliza M. Mackey's personal property be rec<sup>d</sup>, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the report of the sales of certain Real Estate of Samuel Chase dec<sup>d</sup>, made & reported by Richard Millington Adm<sup>r</sup>. with the will annexed of said deceased be ratified & confirmed unless cause to the contrary be shown on or before the first Tuesday in November next, provided a copy of this order be published for three successive weeks previous to the said 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday in November, in some news paper printed on the Eastern Shore of Maryland.
