Ordered that the 8th Guardian account of Mary Burke, ward of Stephen J. Wright Esq. be received, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the Release, from Ann Briggs, John W Gould, and Samuel Plummer, to William Gould, be received, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the last will & testament of Rachael T Lynch, late of Queen Anns County dec^d, be admitted to probate.

On application ordered that letters Testamentary on the estate of the said Rachael T Lynch dec^d, be granted and committed to Ann Maria Lynch the executrix named & daughter of the deceased who executes a bond in the penal sum of \$500. with Wm Henry Miller & Solomon E Lynch as securities.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to William Goldsborough and Alexander W. Thompson to appraise the personal property of Rachael T Lynch aforesaid.
