On application of James & Franklin Bright Executors of the last will & testament of James Bright deceased. Ordered that they sell at public sale & on a credit of six months the whole of the personal property of said deceased, Legacies and Negroes excepted.

Ordered that James & Franklin Bright, executors of James Bright deceased, give the notice required by law to the creditors of said deceased, by causing the same to be published in one of the Centerville News papers.

Ordered that the petition of Harriet Shewbrooks, widow of James Shewbrooks dec^d, be received and filed.
