Ordered that the 3^d Guardian Account of Ann Matilda Downes, ward of Alex^d Godwin be read &c.

Ordered that the Valuation of the real estate of John & Mary E. Wooster, Ward of Bernad R. Downes be read &c.

Ordered that the release from Marmaduke, S. Whites to Edmund Garville be received, filed and recorded.

The Court this day (with the consent of his Father & Mother being present in open Court) Bind negro John Harris, as an apprentice to John W. Chambers, to learn the art and mystery of Agricultural Pursuits.

On application and filing certain remunerations, Ordered that letters of Administration on the estate of Martha Wright late of Queen Anne's County deceased, be granted and committed to William P. Bryan, who executes a bond in the penal sum of five thousand dollars, with James Roe Esq & James Merrick Esq as his securities.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to William P. Bryan and Isaac Mason to appraise the personal property of the said Martha Wright late of Queen Anne's County dec^d.
