The Court met pursuant to adjournment

Ordered that the Inventory of personal property of John S. Polph, dec^d, be received, filed & recorded.

On application of Samuel Polph Adm^r of John S. Polph dec^d ordered that he sell at public sale & on a credit of 6 months the whole of the personal property of said deceased, negroes excepted.

Ordered that Samuel Polph Adm^r of John S. Polph dec^d give the notice required by law to the Creditors of said dec^d, to present their respective claims, by causing the same to be published in one of the Centre Ville News Papers.

On application of M Brown Esq, atty for Wm Chambers who applies for letters of Admⁿ on the estate of John Jackson (free Negro) late of Queen Anne's County, dec^d, Ordered that the Register of Will, give the usual notice of 14 days at the Court House door for persons entitled to the same to take letters as aforesaid on said deceased, estate, or they will be granted to the person now applying.

Order that the Account of Sales of personal property of James B. Williamson, dec^d, be rec^d, filed & recorded.

On application of filing remunerations of parties entitled by law to the same; Ordered that Letters of Administration on the estate of John R. Driver, late of Queen Anne's County, dec^d, be granted & committed to Pere Wilmer jun^r who executes a bond in the penal sum of six thousands dollars, with Pere Wilmer & James Merrick Esqs as sureties.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to John B. Thomas & Christopher Wilkinson to appraise the personal property of John R. Driver, late of Queen Anne's County, dec^d,

On application by petition in writing of Mordecai T Cockey, who intermarried with Ann Bright one of the daughters and Legatees of James Bright dec^d, Ordered by the Court, that James and Franklin Bright Executors of said deceased deliver to the said petitioner & wife, Negroes Mary Ann Slings or Mary Johnson and David, on the said Mordecai executing a refunding bond in the penal sum of four hundred and forty five dollars, with one or more securities to be approved of by said executors.

Ordered that the first guardian accounts (under Act of Assembly of 1820) of Wm T, Sarah E, John H, Hester, Frances Ann, and Catharine V Hewitt, minors and orphan children of John Hewitt, dec^d, be rec^d & recorded.
