Ordered that Letters Testamentary on the estate of Samuel Kirby late of Queen Anne's County dec^d, be granted & committed to Mary Kirby Widow of the deceased & executor appointed who being present executes a Bond in the penal sum of three thousand dollars, with Wm Bryan of Wm, and William A G Mobbs, securities.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to Richard D Larrimore & Edward Bryan to appraise the personal property of said Samuel Kirby, deceased.

On application & filing remuneration, Ordered that Letters of Administration on the personal estate of Christopher P. Mason, late of Queen Anne's County, dec^d, be granted & committed unto John L Price, who executes a bond in the penal sum of five hundred dollars with John H Downes & William Seward, as securities.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to Thomas Bowley & Clinton Wright, to appraise the personal property of Christopher P. Mason, deceased, late of said County.

Ordered that the Release from John Pinder & wife to Solomon Pippin her former Guardian be received, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the 1st 2^d & 3^d Guardian accounts of Samuel J Downes orphan son of John Downes dec^d, & ward of Hugh B Simpson be received, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the 3^d & 2^d final Administration Account of James R Shewbrooks, dec^d, Exhibited by Wm S Price, Executor of James Shewbrooks dec^d, the first Administrator, be received, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the 1st final Administration Account of said James R Shewbrooks dec^d by Wm S Price Administrator de bonis non of said deceased, be received, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the Distribution of the personal estate of said James R Shewbrooks, dec^d by Wm S Price Adm^r, & Wm L. L. L. be received, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the 4th 5th 6th & 7th final Guardian Account of Sarah E Shewbrooks (under Act of Assembly of 1820) Exhibited by Wm S Price, Executor of James Shewbrooks dec^d, be received, filed & recorded.
