The Court met pursuant to adjournment

Ordered that the 3^d Guardian Accounts, of Sarah Jane & Rachael & Scully, wards of James Graham, be recd, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the 4th Guardian Accounts of Charlotte Stevens, ward of A. W. Thompson & wife, be received, filed &c.

Ordered that the 3^d Guardian Accounts of Indiana, Harrison & John J. Masey, wards of Josiah Masey, be received, filed and recorded.

On application of John R. Jeffers, Adm^r. of Ruben Jeffers, ^{dec^d} The Court appoints Charles Stevens and Edmunds Garwill, to divide the negroes belonging to said deceased estate amongst his representatives.

On application of John R. Jeffers, guardian under Act of Assembly of 1820, to Lat. W. Wm. H. Sarah E. Deborah A. & E. H. Jeffers, minors; Ordered that he cause the property of said minors to be repaired to the extent of their income if necessary, & he is hereby authorized to dispose of down wood to aid in the same.

Ordered that the Release from Samuel B. Ruth to his Father & Guardian Francis A. Ruth; be received filed and recorded.

Ordered that the Award between J. R. Garwill & wife Adm^r of Wm. Mason dec^d & Thomas A. Ford Adm^r of Andrew Johnson dec^d; Claimants, & G. S. Linchard & L. Roberts Adm^r of D. B. Norr of Jonathan Nevill dec^d; be received & filed.

On application Ordered that Letters of Admⁿ D. B. Norr on the estate of John Denny, dec^d (late of Queen Anne County) be granted & committed to Jacob J. Denny, who executes a Bond in the penal sum of ten thousand dollars, with James Denny & John Denny, as his securities.

On application; ordered that letters of Administration on the estate of Philemon J. Murphy, late of Queen Anne County dec^d; be granted and committed to his widow Eleanor M. Murphy, who executes a bond in the penal sum of three thousand dollars, with Robert S. Bryan & James Diller, securities.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to Wm. J. Ford & John W. Percy - to appraise the personal property of Philemon J. Murphy, deceased.

Whereas J. W. Esdler, guardian to Emily A. Hendrix has applied to the Orphans Court to allow him to reinvest the sum of twenty two hundred fifty seven dollars, fifty cents belonging to said minor, it being the amount heretofore invested by Madison Brown Adm^r of Charles Hendrix, deceased father of said minor, by a bond of G. S. Hollyday & mortgage of himself & mother Susan Hollyday - which said bond & mortgage has been assigned by S. Madison Brown Adm^r as aforesaid to J. W. Esdler, guardian to said minor; Now it is hereby ordered by the Court that the said J. W. Esdler, guardian as aforesaid, loan to the said G. S. Hollyday the above sum of twenty two hundred fifty seven dollars & fifty cents until the said minor shall arrive to the age of eighteen upon the said G. S. Hollyday executing a bond & mortgage (upon the same property) to said Emily A. Hendrix minor, with interest made payable annually to the guardian of said minor.
