

Centre Ville Tuesday June 25th 1850

The Court met pursuant to adjournment

Ordered that the 3^d & 4th final guardian accounts of Rachael Rebecca Wareham, Ward of James W Wareham, be rec^d filed &c

Ordered that that the account of sales of the personal property of William Primrose, dec^d, be received, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the 2nd final Adm^t account of Margaret Phillips dec^d, be received, filed, and recorded.

Ordered that the 2nd distribution account of said deceased estate, be received, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the 2nd final Adm^t account of the estate of Amelia Reed, dec^d, be received, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the 2nd distribution account of the personal estate of said dec^d, estate, be rec^d, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the Inventory of personal property of Robert J. Browne, deceased, be received, filed & recorded.

On application of Charles C. Browne, Adm^r of Robert J. Browne, dec^d, Ordered that he sell on a credit of six months and at public or private sale at his discretion, the whole of the personal property of said dec^d, Negroes excepted.

Ordered that the Release from Henry Walls to James Reed, Adm^r of Amelia Reed, be rec^d, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the Release from Nathan B Denton to James Reed, Adm^r of Amelia Reed, be rec^d, filed & recorded.

On application, ordered that Letters of Administration on the estate of Nannie R Hollyday, late of Queen Anne's County, deceased, be granted and committed to Henry Hollyday, who executes a bond in the penal sum of two thousand dollars, with John Tilghman & Ann Eliza Jones, securities.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to Mr Stevens and George & Palmer to appraise the personal estate of Nannie R Hollyday late of Queen Anne's County, deceased.

Ordered that Henry Hollyday, Adm^r of Nannie R Hollyday dec^d, give the notice required by law to the creditors of the said deceased to present their respective claims, by causing the notice aforesaid to be published in one of the Centre Ville News papers.

Ordered that Mr H & Roe Adm^r of Thomas E Wright dec^d, give the notice required by law to the creditors of the said dec^d to present their respective claims, by causing the notice aforesaid to be published in a Centre Ville newspaper.
