Ordered that Eleanor M. Murphy Adm^r of Philomena S. Murphy dec^d, give the notice required by law to the Creditors of the deceased to present their respective claims, by causing the said notice to be published in one of the Centre Ville News papers.

On application, Ordered that Pere Wilmer jun^r Adm^r of John R. Driver dec^d, sell at public or private sale (if at private sale for not less than the appraised value) and for cash or on a credit of six months, at his discretion, the whole of the negroes belonging to the estate of the said deceased, the said negroes not to be removed from the State of Maryland.

The Court adjourned till Tuesday week
the 16th day of July Instant.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to John A. Hall & Thomas L. Green to appraise the personal property of said Hester Ann Sperry, deceased.

On application of Charles S. B. Mitchell Ordered that letters of Administration on the estate of his sister Martha Louisa Mitchell, late of Queen Anne's County, deceased, be granted & committed to him, who files a bond (dated 25th June 1850) in the penal sum of twelve thousand dollars, with Mary E. and Charles C. Brown, as Securities.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to Doct. R. Wright & Wm. S. Price, to appraise the personal property of said Martha Louisa Mitchell deceased.

Ordered that a warrant be issued to said Doct. Robert Wright & Wm. S. Price aforesaid to appraise the Real Estate of said Martha Louisa Mitchell, deceased.

The Court appoint the said Doct. Robert Wright and Wm. S. Price, to divide the negroes belonging in part to the estate of said Martha Louisa Mitchell.

Ordered that the Inventory of Personal property of James Hawkins, deceased, be received, filed & recorded.

On application of Pere Tilghman jun^r Adm^r with the will annexed of James Hawkins, dec^d, Ordered that he sell at public sale & on a credit of six months, the whole of the property (personal) of said deceased.

Ordered that the Valuation of the Real Estate of the minor children of Wm. H. Kirby dec^d, be received, filed & do.
