On application of Joseph Smith Adm^r of John Dodd dec^d Ordered that he sell at public sale & on a credit of six months the whole of the personal property of the said deceased.

Ordered that Joseph Smith Adm^r of John Dodd dec^d give the notice required by law to the creditors of the said dec^d to present their respective claims; by causing the same to be published in a Centre Ville Newspaper.

Ordered that the Inventory of the Real Estate of Valin time Hewitt, dec^d be received, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the list of separate debts due James Phillips dec^d be received, filed and recorded.

On application of William Bowen and Rebecca his wife formerly Rebecca Baxter & guardian to Hezekiah, Georgian & Martha L. Baxter, Ordered that a warrant be issued to John B. Thomas and James Turner, to estimate the annual value of the Real estate of the said wards.

On application of William Thomas Ruth and Rachael M. Ruth his wife, formerly Rachael M. Setts & late ward of Joshua Sundergill, ordered that he deliver to the said applicants the whole of the property & funds in his hands as the guardian aforesaid.

Ordered that the Account Sales of personal property of Jonathan Knott dec^d be received, filed & recorded.

Ordered that the 4th Guardian account of George H. Callahan ward of James Gott, be received, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the statement of Claims and dividend of the estate of Matilda Nickerson, dec^d be rec^d filed & recorded.

On application the Court appoint James Sparks, guardian to Thomas & Jane Coleman, Orphan Children of Richard Coleman, & the said guardian files a bond for each ward in the penal sum of one hundred dollars with John W. Chambers and William F. Parrott securities.

On application of John Denny, Adm^r of Mary Denny dec^d, ordered that a second warrants be issued to Edmund Carville & Edward F. H. Brown to appraise additional property belonging to the deceased's estate.

On application of John Denny Adm^r of Benjamin F. Denny dec^d, Ordered that he sell at public or private sale at his discretion (but if at private sale for not less than the appraised value) the whole of the negroes belonging to the said deceased's estate, said negroes not to be removed out of the State of Maryland.
