On application, Ordered that Letters Testamentary on the estate of Thomas A. Ford, dec^d, be granted & committed to Clinton Cook Esquire, the executor named, who executes a bond in the penal sum of ten thousand dollars with Doct^r Robert Goldsborough & William Stevens, securities

Ordered that a warrant be issued to John B. Spencer and William Watson to appraise the personal property of Thomas A. Ford, late of Queen Arms County, deceased.

On application, Ordered that Letters of administration de bonis non, with the Will annexed, on the estate of John Nable, late of Queen Arms County, dec^d, be granted and committed to Clinton Cook Esquire, who executes a bond in the penal sum of three thousand dollars, with Doct^r Robert Goldsborough and William Stevens, securities.

Ordered that the Inventory of personal property of William Joiner dec^d, be received, filed & recorded.

On application of William Joiner Administrator of William Joiner, dec^d, Ordered that he sell at public sale & on a Credit of six months, the whole of the personal property of said deceased, Negroes and plate excepted.

Ordered that William Joiner, Administrator of William Joiner, dec^d, give the notice required by law to the Creditors of the deceased to present their respective claims, by causing the same to be published in one of the Centre Ville News Papers.

Ordered that the report of the persons appointed to divide the negroes belonging to the estate of Benajah Lewinger dec^d, amongst his representatives be received, filed & recorded.
