ordered that the Inventory of personal property including the debts due of John Nicholson decd. returned by John Nicholson Collector be received filed and recorded,

ordered that the account of Sales of personal property of John Tucker decd. be received filed and recorded,

ordered that the 2nd Adm^r account of Samuel R. Story decd. be received filed and recorded,

ordered that the list of separate debts due Samuel R. Story decd. be received filed & recorded,

ordered that the list of desperate debts due Samuel R. Story decd. be received filed & recorded,

ordered that the 1st Adm^r account of John L. Rolph decd. be received filed and recorded,

ordered that a warrant be issued to Wm. Simpkins & Joel Clements to estimate the annual value of real Estate of Charles L. Thomas & Alphonse, Richard, William and Samuel minor children of Charles Adams late of Queen Anne's County deceased,

ordered that the account of Sales of Benjamin Merideth decd. be received filed and recorded,

The Court this day decrees that the paper writing alleged to be the last will of William F. Legg decd. be admitted to probat and that the same is sufficient according to the laws of Maryland to pass the personal property therein mentioned to the several Legates, which decree is directed to be filed and recorded among the papers of the proceedings in said cause.

Pardee one of the witnesses to said paper having been summoned appeared and was sworn the testimony of whom was in open Court taken in writing signed by the witness and filed, case postponed for testimony of other witnesses,
