Ordered that the Court approve the bond of Mathias George & Williams Hester executed by them to J W & Sudler Guardians to Emily Ann Hendrix amount of Bond \$800 Int to be paid Annually, the above being an increase of \$300 on former Bond

Ordered that the Court approve the Bond of William J Sudler, William H Saml & John Rolph given executed to J W & Sudler Guardians to Emily Ann Hendrix for seven hundred dollars, Interest to be paid annually to her Guardians

Ordered that J W & Sudler meet as Guardian

for Emily Ann Hendrix any money he may have in hand as Guardian aforesaid

Ordered that the Bond Alexander Reed, Mrs Williams Reed with Matthew W Dilghmans John Wilkinson and Allen Reed be recd filed and recorded

On application of Christopher Panter Admr James J Panter, Ordered that he sell for the payment of debts either at public or private, the negroes belonging to estate of decd; he having first given notice in one of the papers published in Centerville at least three times before sale, if sold at private sale, not to be sold less than the appraisement and in neither case to be sold out
