On application of Wm Barnes & William B Mafey Admins James Turner dead Ordered that they sell the negroes belonging to the Estate of dead at public or private sale at their discretion, having given notice by publishing twice in one of the news papers published in Centerville, if sold at private sale, the said negroes to be sold for at least five hundred dollars more than the appraisement

if at public sale to be sold on the Court Street Green and in either Case not to be sold out of the State of Maryland, to be sold on a Credit of six months for the payment of debt

Ordered that Joseph H Cook and William A Barton be and are hereby appointed to appraise the personal property of James Turner dead not heretofore appraised

On application of C Cook Esq Attorney for Henry Dukes Admin of Louisa C Ryner Ordered that notice be given to the Creditors of James C Ryner to file their claims for dividend on or before 1st day of May next

Whereas a Controversy has arisen between James H Fountain Surviving partner of Ryner & Fountain and James H Fountain and Mathias George Admin De Bonis Adm of James C Ryner deceased, which the parties are willing to refer to arbitrators, it is hereby agreed that all matters of account and Controversy between the said parties be referred to the arbitration of William A Spencer and Henry Harrison Esq they agreeing to chose a third person and then award or the award of a majority of them in writing to be binding upon the said parties, the said arbitrators to proceed expeditiously on ten days notice
