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of Baltimore County, and the indentures assigned by consent of the father as endorsed on the deed to a citizen of Queen Anne's County and by him assigned to one of the Citizens of Queen Anne's County, from whom the apprentice ran away, and being taken up is brought before this Court to have his term extended according to the acts of Assembly in such case made and provided, influenced by the consent of the father thus giving his consent to the assignment but strongly doubting, whether even that gives this Court jurisdiction, we will give the master the benefit of the doubt and decree that the term of said apprentice be extended one year from the time when his original term of service will have expired.

Ordered that the Release of Mary E. Turner to Edward Swann be read, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the Release of George J. Hurlock to William Hurlock be received, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the Inventory of the personal Estate of J. R. Hendrix (minor) be read, filed and recorded.

Ordered that an account of Interest negro Slave and separate debts due to the Estate of Benjamin Meredith be read, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the second account of Benjamin Meredith deed be read, filed and recorded.

Ordered that an account of negro Slave due the Estate of Joseph W. Price be read, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the 2nd account of Administration on the Estate of Joseph W. Price be read, filed and recorded.

Ordered that Inventory of the Real Estate of Maria Mitchell and M. Louis Mitchell be read, filed and recorded.

On application of J. H. Grand and John A. Hall and Wesley Clement in right of his wife and as Guardian to Jas. R. Kerr ordered that John Brown and W. J. J. be and are hereby appointed to settle all matters of account in dispute between them, they disagreeing to choose a third referee and to proceed ex parte on ten days notice and their or the decision of a majority to be final.

Ordered that the 10th Guardian accounts of Mary A. & J. R. Kerr be read, filed and recorded.

Ordered that the Release of the 13th Price to John Primrose be read, filed and recorded.

Ordered that W. H. Hendrix of New Adm. J. R. Hendrix sell the negroes of J. R. Hendrix, after due notice given in some newspaper at public or private sale, at his discretion if at private sale for a sum not less than \$200. over the appraisement not to be sold out to any person who will remove them out of the State.
