John Homewood his Certificate 500 acres April xxviiith M D C LXXII
Ent. in g. rent roll - Holme Hill Laid out for John Homewood of
this Province a piece of Land called Holme Hill lying in Talbot County on
the north side of Chestnut Creek and on the west side of the western branch of the
S. River. Beginning at a marked oak upon a point and running for
breadth West South West at a branch two hundred and fifty paces to a
marked oak bounded on the west by a Line drawn North North West
from that oak three hundred and twenty paces on the North by a
Line drawn East North East from the end of the North North West
line two hundred and fifty paces until it intersect a parallel drawn
from the western branch on the East by the Branch on the South by
the first West South West line containing, and now laid out for five
hundred acres more or less to be held off the Manor of Baltimore
