Proving October 25th 1683 By virtue of a
warrant for two hundred Acres of Land granted unto John Mecom
of Talbot County bearing date the eighth day of June last and same
assigned unto Benjamin Parrot of the said County as may appear
J^r William Coursey Sur. Deputy of Talbot County under Vincent
Lowe Esq. Sur. Gen. Do humbly Certifie that I have laid out for the
said Parrot a parcel of Land called Parrot's Reserve lying in Talbot
County on the Western side of the Choptank Creek Beginning at a marked
Spanish Oak and running East to the last one hundred and
fifty perches bounding with M^r. Southershayes Land and then run-
ning North West two hundred and eighteen perches and from
thence West South West one hundred and fifty perches and then
South East two hundred and eighteen perches to the first bounded
tree containing and more laid out for two hundred Acres more or
less to be holden of the Mannors of Baltimore —
