

No. 8 1686, Sept. 5 Extract of deed, William Coulbourn to John Wothers, Smiths Clfts, Talbot County

Among the Records of Talbot County and in a Deed from William Coulbourn to John Wothers, it is Recorded as follows to wit
This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of September 1686.
Between the above named William Coulbourn to John Wothers for
and in Consideration of the full quantity of Eight Thousand pounds
of Tobacco, did Sell and Convey, all that parcel of Land, Called
or known by the Name of Smiths Clfts, Situate lying and being
in Talbot County in the Northern main branch of Choptank
River Called by the name of Duckhose Creek on the Western
Side of the said Creek and adjoining to the Land of Peter
Sharp Bounded as followeth Beginning at a Marked Oak Chesnut
Tree being the lowermost Bounded Tree of the said Sharp's Land
and running for breadth from the said Chesnut South down
the Creek Sea hundred and forty perches to a marked Beach
Tree standing upon a point of an Indian's Field Bounded
on the South by a line drawn West for length from the
said Beach Tree five hundred perches on the West by a
line drawn North from the end of the West line Sea
hundred and forty perches untill it intersects a parallel
line with the said Sharp's Land on the North with the said
Land and parallel on the East by the Creek containing
and laid out for Two Thousand Acres more or less, Except
those parts thereof that is already Alienated to the said
John Wothers & Richard Hall
