Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to enrich me
I dispose thereof as followeth, first, I give and bequeath
unto my beloved daughter Deborah Pemberton wife of
my son in law John Pemberton Merchant one Negro
Girl called Hannah and a Negro boy called Jacob
now in the possession of the said John and Deborah
Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved granddaugh-
- ter Fleretta Maria, Margaret and Deborah Lloyd
the sum of thirty pounds sterling apiece to be paid
unto them at the age of sixteen years

Item I give and bequeath and release unto my beloved
son in law John Pemberton all Debts due from him
to me whether by account or otherwise on his own
or my said Daughter Deborah Account

Item I give and bequeath unto my kinswoman Mary
Edmondson wife of Tho^s Edmondson of Talbot Co^y
the sum of thirty pounds sterling and I do also
give and bequeath unto the same Mary all Debts
