An Inquisition Indented and made the 22^d day of May 1745 by us whose
 Names are hereunto subscribed and Seals affixed being legally Summed and Sworn
 to inquire of it would be to the damage of the said Proprietary of this Province
 or to the damage of any other Person and the value of such damage if the said
 Lord Proprietary granted to Thomas Norman of Talbot County Twenty Acres of
 Land to build a Water Mill upon Viz^t Ten Acres on each side the Branch of
 Tuckahoe Creek where formerly stood an Old Mill belonging to Col^o Grundy
 and how and of what value they are by the Year according to the true
 value thereof. We find that it is not any prejudice to the Lord
 Proprietary for the said Thomas Norman to build a Mill on the Run of Tuckahoe
 Creek where formerly stood a Mill called Grundy's Mill, We likewise find that nine
 of the ten acres on the South side of the branch aforesaid is part of a Tract of Land
 called Smiths Clift and belonging to Sarah Morgan Widow of Jacob Morgan late
 of the Island of Antigua and that it will be to the damage of the said Sarah the
 Sum of two Shillings and three ^{pence} Year Current Money of Maryland likewise We
 find that one acre of the aforesaid ten acres of the South side of the aforesaid Run
 part of Smiths Clift belongs to Richard Hall and will be to the damage of the said
 Norman builds a Mill on the Run aforesaid the sum of three pence Current Money of
 Maryland & Year likewise we find that the ten acres on the North side of the
 said Run is part of Smiths Clift and belongs to Richard Hall and that it will be
 to the damage of the said Richard the sum of three Shillings Current Money & Year
 if the said Thomas Norman builds a Water Mill on the Run aforesaid And we do find
 that there remains 254 acres to the said Sarah Morgan and likewise there remains to
 the said Richard Hall 250 acres As Witnesses Our hands and seals
