In obedience to the Writ aforesaid whereby it doth appear to have been
found that Twenty acres of land lying on each side of the aforesaid branch
beginning at a marked Sycamore Tree standing on the South side of the aforesaid
-said Run marked with twelve Notches and Cuts from thence West four
Furlongs then South five degrees West forty Furlongs and East fifty four
and North ten degrees West thirty five Furlongs, and South fifty six degrees
West eight Furlongs and North sixty three degrees West fourteen Furlongs &
North twenty degrees West ten Furlongs and North fifty three degrees West six
Furlongs to the beginning is part of a tract of land called Smiths Cliffs and
that nine Acres thereof belong to Sarah Morgan Widow of Jacob Morgan late
of the Island of Antigua and that it will be to the damage of the said
Sarah the sum of Two Shillings and three Pence per Year Current Money of
Maryland and that one Acre on the South side of the aforesaid branch of
Smiths Cliffs belongs to Richard Hall and that it will be to the damage
of the said Richard Hall three Pence Current Money per Year.
