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




I Give and Bequeath unto my Brother Thomas Baynard all my Lands together with my Sheep Pen Chatter Hogs Household Goods (unless Bed only excepted with the furniture and covering thereof belonging for me and Tobacco. Item I Give and Bequeath unto my beloved Mother Sarah Sprinall one Bed with Furniture and covering thereof belonging

Lastly I constitute and appoint make and Ordain my Brother Thomas Baynard and my beloved Mother Sarah Sprinall to be my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disannul revoke and disannull all every other former Testaments Wills and Legacies Requests and Executors by one in any way before this Time named last and Bequeathed ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and Year above written
