Item, I give and bequeath unto my said Nephew Stanley Robins the several Negroes following to wit, Harry, Jamey, Solomon, Dick, Tammer, Violet, Lydia, ^{and} Nan to be delivered to him the same Stanley Robins (if they are alive) by my Executor hereafter named when he shall attain to the age of twenty one years

Item, I give and bequeath all the residue and remaining part of my personal Estate of what nature or kind soever (my just Debts and funeral Expences being first paid and satisfied) unto my said nephew Stanley Robins to be delivered and paid to him by my Executor hereafter named when he the same Stanley Robins shall attain to the age of twenty one years

Item, It is my Will and Desire and I do hereby order and direct that my lands above devised to the said Stanley Robins and the said Negroes and personal Estate so as afo. to him given shall be held possessed and enjoyed by my Executor hereafter named until the said Stanley Robins shall arrive to the age of twenty one years without being in any sort accountable to him for the profits and produce thereof any other than to maintain and Educate the same Stanley Robins in such manner as my said Executor shall deem just and right. And it is further my Will

and Desire, and I do hereby request that my said Executor shall have the Guardianship and Tutition of the said Stanley Robins untill he shall arrive to the age afo.

Lastly I constitute and appoint my kinsman John Goldborough the Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all other and former Will or Wills by me made.
