David Harrington of Talbot County
aged 46 years said that the first
boundary tree of a tract of land
called Smiths Cliffs is a Chesnut
tree standing on the bank near
the creek said of the said
Harrington. shown to Jack Millin
& Ja Gilson of the said county a white
tree that had blown down upon
a point called the Harps Point & that
said oak was shown to him by his
father Anthony Harrington & it
was the second tree of the said
tract of land called Smiths Cliffs.
