Smiths Cliffs surveyed 2^d July 1665 for
William Smith - 2000 acres -
Ruth Hall purchased 500 but within
the lines of his 570 acres are included
Jⁿ° Watters purchased residue of the tract
but upon survey it was found to contain
1030 acres only.

Jⁿ° Watters left this (the residue) to his
four sons, viz. John, Jacob, Richard and
Philip -

Philip 7th Oct. 1710 conveyed 230 acres
to Jⁿ° Conroy -

Jⁿ° Conroy 24th March 1719 conveyed the
230 acres to Sarah Morgan (of Antigua)

Holme in Holme Hill surveyed 20th
Apr. 1664 for Jⁿ° Hammond 500 acres.
This tract held in parcels by survey -

Jⁿ° Conroy 24th March 1719 conveyed 62^{ac}
