The Tobacco hogsheads not having arrived I take this opportunity to inclose a sketch of all the information Mr. Fisher recollects respecting your lands in Tuckahoe also a plat shewing the variation and distance as run from the Great Oak on the Bank to the gums.

Instead of 60 yards Ognabrigs that you told me was and there is 65 3/4 yards, and this is ~~for~~ short of the quantity bid. 14 1/2 yards, which you will please to send by the Bearer also thread to make up the whole of the linen to prevent as many blunders in the business and for your satisfaction I have inclosed a particular list of those who are served and those that are still to have.
