Deed, John Edmondson to Peter Harris [original], recorded Aug. 4, 1807 Parrott's Reserve, Talbot County
Acknowledgment of deed by John Edmondson before Peter Denney and Henry Nicols [original]

This Indenture made this Twentieth day of March
Eighteen hundred and seven between John Edmondson of
Talbot County and State of Maryland of the one part
and Peter Harris of the said County and State aforesaid
of the other part - Whereas by Decree of the Chancery
Court of the State aforesaid bearing Date the Twentieth
day of July Eighteen hundred and two the above
named John Edmondson was appointed a Trustee
and authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of
part of the Real Estate of Richard Johns of Talbot County
deceased, for the payment of a Debt due to a certain
John Dickerson of the said County - That in pursuance
of the said Decree the said John Edmondson did on
the Ninth day of June Eighteen hundred and seven
sell and dispose of at Public Auction to one
named Peter Harris a Tract of Land called Parrott's
Reserve, at and for the sum of Six hundred and
fifty Dollars Current Money. And Whereas the
purchase Money for the said Tract of Land and
Premises hath been fully paid and satisfied and the
said John Edmondson is authorized by the said Decree
to execute a conveyance for the same, and to comply
with the terms of the said Decree the said John
Edmondson hath agreed to execute these presents -
Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said John
Edmondson in consideration of the above recited pre-
mises and of one Dollar to him in hand paid
by the said Peter Harris, the Receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, and himself therewith to be paid
