bargain sell, release alien, enfeoff and confirm

forever all that Tract or parcel of Land called
Parrott's Reserve lying in Talbot County on the
left side of Tuckahoe Creek Beginning at a marked
Spanish Oak and running East north East One hundred
and fifty perches, binding with William Southby's Land
and then running North West two hundred and Eighteen
perches and from thence West South West one hundred
and fifty perches and then South East two hundred and
Eighteen perches to the first Bounded Tract containing
and bounded for two hundred acres more or less -

with the up Land, branches, Waters, Water Course
Wood, Inclosures and other Improvements, and Privileges to
the same appertaining. And the Reversion and Reversions
remainder and Remainders, Rents, Issues, profits, Emoluments
and Services thereof and, every part and parcel thereof And
also all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest, property, Claim
and Demand, both in Law, and Equity, as well of Him
