What when I bought it and I have had it in my Inclosure ever since till now it is turned out George Thompson did claim a right to land but not to the fence neither when Sheriff sold to me nor since in my hearing ~~he~~ was present when I asked Sheriff whose fence that was the answer Sheriff made was it was his fence he set it there with Georges consent and that if it should be on Georges land when the Bounds was settled that he had liberty to move it off any time when he pleased and George never controverted it

My Tenant gave George Thompsons Tenant liberty to tend a piece of ground in Corn one Year within his Inclosure where John Fisher run a supposed line to come near to the quantity as he could that he might receive pay for that quantity but my Deed is to such and such line of the original purchase when the Bounds comes to be settled and if it should include more Sheriff has my Bond for a further quantity of Cash so much per Acre for all included John Woollers divides his land between his four sons and they have divided contrary to what the lands are now held and they have been ever moving the Bounds.
