Memorandum. Richard Hall purchased by
Deed but 560 Acres but within the lines is
contained 578 Acres, John Wootten purchased
the remainder but upon survey it was
found to be but 1032 Acres. which he
left equally to his 4 sons. Viz. John,
Richard, Jacob, & Phillip, Richard
gave 232 Acres of his share to Mr. Landry
& 26 to William Tupper. - - -

Smiths Cliffs - Patented to William Smith 2000. March 3. 1661.
Wm Smith died & Willed the said land to Mary his Wife the 18th December 1667
Mary the Wife of Wm Smith died without Will and the said land descended to Hannah
Her Sister and Sole Heir

Hannah Married with a certain Vincent Atcheson -

Atcheson & Wife conveyed to Wm Colburne of Somerset County the 27th November 1674
Colburne to Hall the 25th February 1680. 560 -

Colburne to Wootten the 25th Day of Feb. 1680.
Wootten left the same land to his 4 sons
John - Jacob - Richard - Phillip
Phillip Wootten to John Conny Oct. 7. 1718
John Conny to Sarah Morgan March 24. 1719

Sarah Morgan Youngest daughter of John Conny
Bennett Esq 238 Acres of Smiths Cliffs
then went to Antigua by Deed The same
Brother Dying here in Maryland
