Seedling from single plough & double plough

Wednesday 22<sup>th</sup>  
Seedling do - do -

Thursday 23<sup>th</sup>  
Seedling - sent to Pittsborough & bought 13 bu - of Blue stem wheat of E. Mann at 90c

Friday 24<sup>th</sup>  
13 bu of James' seedling at what his wheat heard him in Baltimore

Saturday 25<sup>th</sup>  
finished getting in my corn all to a few loads went to the school house in the morning and voted for Trustees

Sunday 26<sup>th</sup>  
Raining and mucky all day

Monday 27<sup>th</sup>  
finished getting in my corn in the field and commenced seeding again

Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup>  
seeding the Mediterranean I got from Scrato

Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup>  
finished the left hand side of the field as you go to the creek about 2 o'clock A.M. rained in the afternoon

Thursday 30<sup>th</sup>  
Raining as hard as it can well pour down

Friday 31<sup>st</sup>  
commenced seeding the quarter lot of garden lot finished & commenced seeding the cut back of the granary with <sup>blue stem</sup> wheat also the aforesaid lot 13 bu - of <sup>blue stem</sup> wheat in all

Saturday 1<sup>st</sup>  
seeding <sup>blue stem</sup> wheat in the granary cut

Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Nothing much of consequence

Monday 3<sup>rd</sup>  
finished seeding my <sup>blue stem</sup> wheat and all my wheat

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup>

Auspicious & loftying corn

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup>

Friday 7<sup>th</sup>

Saturday 8<sup>th</sup>  
Brightest and blocked up my corn house ready for corn
