 Monday 16th Commenced harvesting corn the 1st time Stephen and George thinning. Plots for very sore cut it with axes not able to work
 Tuesday 17th Boys employed ditto
 Wednesday 18th do - clear and very warm
 Thursday 19th do - - -
 Friday 20th do - - -
 Saturday 21th finished harrowing and thinning the creek field about 10 o'clock commenced in the loft in the evening
 Sunday 22th Turned out with the odd fellows in the funeral procession over William Allison Brother Shivers preached an excellent funeral sermon cloudy all day with an appearance of rain wind easterly very pleasant
 Monday 23th Whitsuntide holidays gave the boys holiday
 Tuesday 24th caught 20 Chads on Monday night 11 on Tuesday night
 Wednesday 25th the little horse foot a little better worked him from breakfast till dinner finished the lot a little before night
 Thursday 26th Perry ploughing team in the track patch Stephen at work in the garden
 Friday 27th Ploughing corn running. Ploughed George following the plough ground dry and hard
 Saturday 28th ditto
 Sunday 29th Rained as usual doing nothing

Monday 16th Stephen and Perry ploughing wind easterly felt very much all day took my horse went down to Hillborough to the lodge Willis invited Dukes to dig whole amount paid into the lodge \$2.25
 Tuesday 17th Dry and cool Boys up to do - - -
 Wednesday 18th unseasonably cool no rain perfect brought corn suffering wheat doing very well do - do
 Thursday 19th very warm roads dusty J. O. Martin came down to see me went to Hillborough and settled over business amicably with James J. Barwick came back before night exchanged horses Martin went home walked down to the mill miserable enough came back the same horse \$5.00 of J. O. M. for harvest
 Friday 20th Dry and cool finished ploughing corn
 Saturday 21th Lonesome as an owl - -
 Sunday 22th not much a doing no rain
 Monday 23th Wednesday 25th Thursday 26th
 Tuesday 24th Boys cut wheat for Mr. Sur Britton at \$1.50 per day gave them \$3.00 a piece
 Friday 27th commenced cutting my Mediterranean wheat men one cradle untill 12 o'clock Stephen cutting Perry binding after dinner run two cradles Perry cutting and Becca binding Paid John Small 50 cts for binding Becca not paid
 Saturday 28th Stephen and myself cutting Becca & the Perry binding the old man George and Bill setting up finished my Mediterranean about 11 o'clock and commenced

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
