Sunday 11th weather beautiful not a breath of wind saddled my horse Thomas fuel and myself rode over in caroline to Mr George. Collison's was not at home come on around by the goose pond stopped at Mr. Richards. Lons was not at home came back about dinner time corn coming up finely. Went to the mill in the evening took supper let Stephen haul the skin on Shers caught very few Perry ploughing and heading rails. Went down to hillborough in the evening with Thomas fuel took a degree of Mr. Enitiated into the independent order of odd fellows all right.

Monday 12th Stephen hauling the skin Perry ploughing weather very fine but extremely warm.

Tuesday 13th weather very fine but extremely warm.

Wednesday 14th weather very warm boys employed do myself fished with a hook and line found a very large turtle brought him home.

Thursday 15th fair and pleasant not much a doing.

Friday 16th clear with a little shower in the evening.

Saturday 17th finished putting up manure on the lot.

Sunday 18th Lawrence and myself went down to Hillsborough in the evening.

Monday 19th sent my horse I want to Mr Smith to go to Easton.

Tuesday 20th commenced dragging and replanting corn. Rained heavy in the evening.

Wednesday 21st ground too wet to drag the Old man. Went to Easton 19 year locusts came about very thick.

Thursday 22nd commenced dragging again ground in very good order.

Friday 23rd clear the wind to the north & east blowing very heavy clouded up about night with the appearance of rain. Perry dragging Stephen George & the Old man replanting corn. Mr. Smith & her mother came over in the evening took supper went down to the mill after supper & talked a while with Mr. Smith alone in time for prayers.

Saturday 24th Rained last night very hard ground rather too wet to work corn.

Sunday 25th Joshua Emerson came over before breakfast went over in caroline together engaged over a box very well got home about 9 o'clock at night.

Monday 26th finished dragging my corn about 10 o'clock. Perry hauling manure in the evening Stephen at work in the garden.

Tuesday 27th Perry & storm & Perry employed ditto very dry.

Wednesday 28th boys employed do clear & warm.

Thursday 29th Perry ploughing in the State patch Stephen doing up the Old over lot fence finished in the evening. Went over to Mr. Bartlett to borrow his bagrow. Mr. Bartlett not at home. Beautiful rain that evening and night wind W. N. W.

Friday 30th Got Lawrence Smith to make me a harrow carried & drag both to v. Mc Clements to get them flattened out charged me 30 to a piece. Lawrence charged me 2.50.
