

Wednesday 31st finished fencing in the garden & manuring it
 Thursday 31st turned to and ploughed it up all ready for planting seed & potatoes
 Friday 31st at work in the garden planted potatoes and other seed
 Saturday 31st commenced ploughing in oats ploughed in 5 bushels all that I had at that time had a piece of ground left nothing in it
 Sunday 30th In the morning cloudy with the appearance of rain. after dinner went over in barrow and took a look at the country got home a little before eight.
 Monday 31st set Stephen to sowing in the crop field and Perry to chugging the oats finished before night and took the little plough and run the furrows out and commenced breaking ground in the creek field for corn.
 Tuesday April 1st Stephen breaking ground and Perry & myself commenced fishing caught 12 I had got home about dark Eliza Bartlett struck with the paralytick in the morn & died about 10 o'clock Francis came over after me to set up & for one of the boys to go and dig the grave told him yes the 1st word went over about night and set up all night came home in the morning sent Perry to dig the grave and went to the funeral myself went a fishing in the evening got 11 had
 Wednesday 2nd caught 13 had and 2 mullets
 Thursday 3rd caught 13 had & one mullet

Saturday 5th caught 7 had poor business Mr Bartlett took his two heifer home
 Sunday 6th kept best part of the day
 Monday 7th caught 11 had Stephen ploughing
 Tuesday 8th raining & blowing wind southeast caught 14 had
 Wednesday 9th wind to the southward caught 9 had
 Thursday 10th hailing manure ploughing oats. ungear'd & gear'd my scin over again caught 1 I had in the evening wind southeast ploughing and hauling manure
 Friday 11th rose about 2 hours before day fished down as far as star-bit and back sold 4 had at the mill to a fish huckster for 28 cts brought home and sold them to brown. kept 12 cts & 70 cts being our days work.
 Saturday 12th Perry ploughing Stephen hauling manure with me Bartlett oxen George casting shovels in the lot over the road finished in the evening myself doing nothing went down to the mill caught 12 cts worth of lobsters paid for it
 Sunday 13th Thursday night I found 1 shot 4 of number 1 box of caps - caps 50 - shot & powder & not paid
 Monday 14th wind south east and raining in the evening sister and myself took dinner & supper at the mill came home in the evening
 Tuesday 15th sent Mr Bartlett cow and ox home on Saturday 5th Mr Bartlett came after his 2 heifers took them home.
 Wednesday 16th caught 25 I had got home about night Stephen ploughing big horse taken very sick expected to lose him got better after a while
 Thursday 17th caught 17 I had gained very hard all day wind north & by west myself nearly frozen
 Friday 18th caught 3 I had rained a little in the morning wind north west very disagreeable
 Saturday 19th caught 6 I had wind north west and weather

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
