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Sunday 2nd Dick & his wife came over & took dinner with me in the evening. Smith & Arthur Krine came over & talked a while passed the best part of the day at home weather beautiful

Monday the weather very fine boys setting rails.

Tuesday 4th got ready and went to Eastern carried my seine rope & got it exchanged & bought 6th cotton for \$1.00 got home before night

Wednesday 5th weather tolerable pleasant boys making rails

Thursday 6th at work all day making cortas for my seine finished about night boys finished the back fence down to the creek

Friday 7th went a ducking no game raining snowing blowing & hailing all day & night. boys shelling corn

Saturday 8th ground covered over with snow sent Perry to mill not much a doing could not get the meat till Monday

Sunday 9th then rose early steadily with the appearance of rain stayed home till 12 o'clock eat my dinner saddled my horse & rode over to James Ridgways to take a look at his mare came home nearly night

Monday 10th blowing heavy all day wind about from west boys getting rails and fencing.

Tuesday 11th More went over to Eastern early in the morning to make rope for my float seine the wind blew so hard could only make one had Perry & the old man helping so they went on home I waited to see Mr. Ridgway in bargain about the mare & gave him my note for seventy five dollars payable 12 months after date brought her home same evening

Wednesday 12th Went over to Eastern made 3 more ropes all I had to make brought them home done very well William took stall all night with me

Thursday 13th morning but my ropes in the pot and boiled them I shall spell them took them out and shedded them to the apple trees then took my horse & cart & went over to Boston & bought 15 bushels of oats & 2 bushels of Potatoes got home a little before night

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11th March

Friday 14th Fine early, weather beautiful boys fencing rope run a fox across the field tightened my ropes up & gave them another stretching went down to Stillborough to see Samuel & Benwick about the fishery not at home no agreement between us nothing settled

Saturday 15th More cloudy with the appearance of rain cleared away after a while went over to my J. Gaffins to the banking made them went over with Dick and took supper having borrowed Smith's mare came home about 10 o'clock commenced raining about the time I got home rained tremendous hard all night. left my seine ropes out in the rain all night. forgot them.

Sunday 16th continued raining off and on all day went out before breakfast took my ropes in out of the rain stayed home all day

Monday 17th St. Patrick's day Snowed very fast all day sometimes accompanied with rain wind with by west boys doing nothing all day Jack found guilty of putting eggs caught in the act. went to bed about 11 o'clock still snowing very fast.

Tuesday 18th stop snowing sometime in the night but commenced raining and snowing in the morning weather very unpleasant

Wednesday 19th but voted to build my fish house and put some of them up

Thursday 20th weather fine still working on the house

Friday 21th weather fine do

Saturday 22th weather fine finished the house about 3 pm

Sunday 23th cloudy accompanied with a little rain

Monday 24th Not doing much of any thing sprouting

Tuesday 25th fencing in the garden and at night hauling rails to Bought 3 barrels of salt at a 25¢

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
