Rose early in the morning to time enough for to nit a float seen went to look for some person to nit it stopped at Mr. Carters on my way fell in with widow Stanton went down to Thomas Coveys engaged Mr. Covey to nit my seen at 30¢ per yard sent to Mr. Carters after the time and took it to her Joshua Emerson went a gunning after dinner not much game stopped at Mrs. Dommys as we came back I had a short chat with the girls also stopped at Mr. Carters His 5¢ V. Ridgeway been taking pills as hot as cotton settled it all with a hoe down clear with the wind to the eastward came home went to bed.

Morning Rose early and got ready to go to Easton Joshua Strick & myself all went along together stopped at the Chapple & took a glass of love cordial nearly 12 o'clock when we got to Easton Met J. O. M. and was badly disappointed in my expectations

Rose early rainy and had all day could not do much of any thing the boys shell'd corn to go to Mill. carried it down could not grind it untill Monday morning on account of the heavy fresh of water coming down I felt very unwell all day having a dose of Martins pills the over night they did not operate so as to relieve my head wore of though after a while still continued rainy and had went to bed rather earlier than common
