

Nov 20<sup>th</sup> 1841

Dear Sir I have finished my Corn and  
I send Firsby with a good load of Oysters with the  
measures for the Peoples Moor - We are now busy fixing  
the Feed yard for the Stock I found the fattening steers  
with the Indifferent Corn in bad weather I think  
they are fine Beef now. I have 165 Barrells of Corn  
now beside the Indifferent Corn that Fattening Hogs wont  
Eat I seeded 63<sup>h</sup> Bushells of Wheat in the Field and  
13<sup>h</sup> in the Lott and it Comes up Very Slow -  
as I Expect you Down in a Very short time and Paper  
Scarce I have to cut short by saying you may send by  
Firsby my suit of Cloth if convenient.
