Sir

I herewith enclose a Roll of the
Inhabitants of Florida remaining on the drawing list
at this station, on the 30th Nov 1837. In making
this Roll, I omitted the names of those whom
I considered no longer entitled to rations.
Of the names remaining on the list, several are
marked by the letter (d) indicating that those
cases are doubtful. These names are not thus
marked to suggest the discontinuance of rations
to the individuals; but merely for your information
that you may make such enquiries as may enable
you to decide on the justice of their claims.

Orders having been received from the Com-
manding General, transferring the whole matter
to the Commissioners appointed by the Secretary of
War, and directing a discontinuance of the issues
by Officers of the Subsistence Dept. of the Army; no
issues were made on Wednesday & Thursday last (the
regular issuing days) at this station. The appropri-
ate column on the Roll indicates the days (inclu-
sive) up to which issues have been made.
