

Oliver Field Sept 22^a 1847

Dear John

I have put off writing to you for so long a time simply because I was not assured as to what my arrangements would be, I believe they are at last determined on, I am to be married on the 14th of October in the morning in Church and have ~~Carlish~~ the same day for Phila. There are to be but two Bridesmaids and the groomsmen will be Sumner Brown and Brother, - but I sincerely hope that that arrangement will in no manner detain you from accompanying me, I should like above all things if you can go, we will leave here on the 11th which will be Monday and reach there Wednesday evening and I shall be married next morning.

Billy Bensley will go and I expect Aldrige, I intend writing to Chamber Wickers, if it is possible I particularly desire you to be with me, let me hear from you
