

Oak Grove July 31 1865

My Dear Sir

I arrived home about 9 o'clock in the evening of the day I left your hospitable mansion. glad was I, to reach home so hot & disagreeable.

I received a letter from Col Woolford yesterday requesting me to meet the State Central Committee at Barnum's Wednesday August 2 at ten o'clock a.m. it will be out of my power to meet the committee at that time,

As you suggested I sent you two bills. I will take it as a great favor if you with your friends would send your orders for twenty or more tons of Whiting's Phosphate. please send the order as early as possible to give me time to have it shipped, that you may get it for early sending. I will deliver the Phosphate at Baltimore for \$58 ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ per ton.
