

Know all men by these presents that I John
A Emory of Duane County in the State of Maryland
am held and firmly bound unto William H Emory
son of the City of Washington in the District of Columbia
in the full and just sum of eight thousand dollars
current money, to be paid to the said William H Emory or
his certain attorney executor administrators or assigns to
which payment well and truly to be made and done I bind
myself my heirs executors and administrators firmly by
these presents sealed with my seal and dated this
fourteenth day of April in the year of our Lord
eight hundred and fifty three.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if
the above bound John A Emory his heirs executors or
administrators do and shall well and truly pay or cause
to be paid unto the above named William H Emory his
executors administrators or assigns the full and just sum
of four thousand dollars current money in three equal annual
installments the first of which installments to be paid at the end
of one year next after the death of Mrs. Sarah Emory the
mother of the said John A and William H Emory and the
second and third of said installments to be paid at the end of
two and three years respectively from the death of said Mrs.
Sarah M. Emory with interest on the whole sum due annually
the said interest to commence at the death of said Mrs. Sarah
